How does DWM protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</li> <li>sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> <li>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</li> </ul>	
Definitions		
Affiliates	<ul> <li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Our affiliates include companies such as Eden Investment Partners LLC, Eden Partners Absolute Growth Fund LP, and Steamboat Fund LP</li> </ul>	
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li><i>DWM does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul>	
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul> <li><i>DWM does not jointly market.</i></li> </ul>
